Privacy Statement

This privacy statement pertains to the processing of personal data by Bergschenhoek Groep BV and its subsidiaries located at Boterdorpseweg 10 (2661AC) in Bergschenhoek, registered in the Dutch Chamber of Commerce under number [24290088] (hereinafter: "we" or "us").

In this policy, we describe which personal data we collect from you, how we handle this personal data, and the rights you have in this context.

1. PERSONAL DATA AND PURPOSES

Personal data is any information that can identify a natural person (directly or indirectly). Personal data can be a name or phone number, but also a date of birth or email address, for example. We collect personal data for the following purposes:

Website Visits

When visiting our website, data such as IP addresses or email addresses are obtained.

Requests for Documentation or Purchases

When you request documentation, provide contact information, or make a purchase, we collect personal data to inform you about your purchase and new products/services.

Job Applications

If you apply for a job, we collect the data you provide, including name, address, and contact details (NAW), CV, copies of diplomas, or certificates, to assess your suitability for the position or to maintain contact during the application process. We process this data based on Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, as we have a legitimate interest because, without this data, we cannot assess your suitability for the position or inform you about the progress of the application process.

Providing your personal data is not a legal requirement nor a necessary condition for entering into a contract. However, if you do not provide us with the personal data, we may not be able to process your application.

Customers/Suppliers

From individuals working at a customer and/or supplier, we collect contact details (name, phone number, address, email address, signature, and possibly other data necessary for communication) to maintain contact regarding the execution and billing of products or services supplied or purchased. We process this personal data based on Article 6(1)(b) or (f) of the GDPR because it is necessary to process this personal data for the execution of the agreement with our customers or suppliers. Providing personal data is not a legal requirement. However, providing the personal data is a necessary condition for entering into or executing an assignment or contract. We do not retain personal data longer than necessary, processing personal data in an agreement until a maximum of 7 years after the end of the business relationship.

2. WITH WHOM DO WE SHARE PERSONAL DATA?

We may share personal data with third parties who process this data on our behalf, for example, for the maintenance and security of our IT systems.

These third parties are our processors and process the data only on our behalf and for no other purpose. We do not transfer your personal data to (legal) entities outside the European Economic Area.

3. RETENTION PERIODS

After fulfilling your request, we delete the data after 4 weeks.

We retain applicant data until a maximum of four weeks after the end of the application period. If you have given permission to keep your data so that we can inform you about future vacancies, we will retain your data until a maximum of one year after the end of the application procedure. You can withdraw this consent at any time.

4. SECURITY OF PERSONAL DATA

We have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to secure your personal data against loss or other forms of unlawful processing.

5. CHANGES TO OUR PRIVACY POLICY

This privacy statement was last updated on April 22, 2024. We may change this privacy policy from time to time by publishing the revised version on this page. You are therefore advised to regularly consult this page.

6. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to request us to:

- Provide access to your personal data;
- Supplement, correct, or delete your personal data;
- Object to the processing of your personal data;
- Restrict the processing of your personal data; and/or
- Transfer your personal data to you or a third party.

These rights are not absolute. We will assess your request in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). We will provide you with information about the actions we have taken in response to your request as soon as possible, but in any case within one month of receiving your request. We may extend this period by two months due to the complexity of your request or the number of requests we receive. We will inform you in such a case. You have the right to file a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority at any time.
